Take Action by Learning About Civil Rights Actions Today

- 1. Choose one of the following topics about the continuing fight for civil rights today:
 - Racism: Conduct research to find out what is being done to fight racism today.
 - Bullying: Conduct research to find out what is being done to protect the rights of those who are bullied online or in person.
 - Mental Health: Conduct research to find out what is being done to protect the rights of those who need support for mental health issues.
- 2. Ask Questions Generate a list of questions about the topic you have selected. What might you want to know about your topic?
- 3. Learn about your topic by using a variety of sources. Use the Internet or your library to find newspaper or magazine articles, data, or interviews with people involved in a civil rights issue of your choice.
- 4. Raise Awareness Create a photo gallery or poster aimed at raising awareness about the civil rights issue you researched. Share your gallery or poster with members of the community by posting it at a community center, library, or public space.
